

Sunday 29th October BUILDING AN OTTER HOTEL 10.30 to 12.30





We'll try again! We couldn't carry out this work in September as the water level was too high. The contractor has been on site and it is ready for us to do our bit to build an OTTER HOLT in the wetland area of the Local Nature Reserve. We shall use wood from the coppicing to build the holts and the pile of chippings will be used to improve the path that leads into the reeds.

If the wet water level rises again we may. Instead, have to clear the encroaching Sea Buckthorn on the main dunes path and the sand ramp from the Main CP.

Tools will not be required for the wetland work, but we shall bring our loppers, secateurs, saws etc for the path clearing.
