Around 60 members came to the AGM and I would like to thank them for coming to support Friends of Par Beach and to choose new Officers and Committee.

Those who were not able to join us at the AGM may have read the piece in Cornish Guardian this week, and I am happy confirm that Friends of Par Beach will be continuing with its work on conservation, management of the site, promoting events, supporting stakeholders and providing access for all.

- Fourteen events were organised by Friends of Par Beach in our first year, which I believe is a great achievement. A winter/spring programme will be announced soon.
- Contacts have been forged with stakeholders such as Parish Council, County Council, Ecobos, Serco, Par Sands Holiday Park, Environment Agency, Natural England and Cornwall Wildlife Trust.
- Major grants were awarded by the Co-op Bank Community Fund and the Cornwall Council Community Fund to set up Friends of Par Beach and we are in the process of identifying the best way to use this money for the benefit of Par Beach and its members.
- Two resolutions were passed at the AGM by a very large majority.
 - i) That Friends of Par Beach supports the principle that Par Beach and Par Beach Local Nature Reserve remain in public ownership in perpetuity.
 - ii) That Friends of Par Beach supports the proposal that the paths to and around Par Beach become Public Rights of Way
- We have recently applied for funding of projects specific to the Par Beach and hope to be able to make an announcement soon.
